- **Reading** The complex passages on this exam require more than a casual reading. In this review you will be taught to actively evaluate the content, structure, and details of the text in order to read with understanding and discrimination.
- **English** These problems test the range of your vocabulary and your ability to understand relationships between words. The review will cover the ten most common relationships used on this test and give you a strategy for vocabulary reinforcement.
- **Math** Quantitative comparison and discrete quantitative questions test your knowledge of arithmetic, algebra, and geometry concepts such as weighted averages, proportions, factoring polynomials, and principles of right triangles. You will be given strategies for applying these concepts to the types of word problems that appear on the test.
- **Science Reasoning** Without a strategy, approaching this type of question ranges from frustrating to impossible. Learn to develop systems of diagraming and coding conditions to draw correct conclusions and solve problems.
